Special Education and Section 504

- Special Education services provided for students meeting IDEA criteria
 - Individual Education Programs (IEPs) developed and revised annually
 - Reassessed every three years
 - primarily served in the general classroom (co-teaching)
 - Pull-out as needed for more intensive, specially designed instruction
- Section 504 services provided to students who have a physical or mental impairment that is substantially limiting a major life activity (i.e., caring for one's self, performing manual tasks, walking, seeing, hearing, speaking, breathing, learning, and working).
 - \circ ~ 504 Plans developed and revised annually
 - Reassessed every three years
 - Served in the general classroom
